There will also be a discussion on practical classroom applications.

Social Media in the Classroom
with Maryam Maori

This session will start by defining and exploring Web 2.0 and its potential place in education. It will then turn into a hands-on workshop where participants will set-up and use a social cataloguing and networking site called Shelfari and a social bookmarking and annotating site called Diigo. If time permits, the session will end with aggregating the discussed tools into an angoogle page.
